PART NO. 13-250A HANDLEBAR SADDLE CLAMP UPDATE

INSTALLING SPEAKERS USING UNIVERSAL HANDLEBAR SADDLE CLAMPS

PLEASE READ THROUGH AND UNDERSTAND THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING.

- 1. MEASURE THE HANDLEBARS DIAMETER.
- 2. IF YOU HAVE 1" DIAMETER HANDLEBAR YOU WILL ONLY NEED TO USE THE 82MM (3-1/4") LONG RUBBER SPACER. IF YOU HAVE 7/8" HANDLEBARS YOU WILL NEED TO USE BOTH THE 82MM (3-1/4") LONG AND THE 50MM (2") LONG SPACERS.
- 3. SLIDE THE HANDLEBAR SADDLE CLAMP OVER HANDLEBAR WITH THE LOWER RECESS FOR THE M4 HEX NUT FACING THE FRONT OF THE BIKE. (SEE FIG. 1)
- 4. WRAP THE RUBBER SPACERS AROUND THE HANDLEBAR AND SLIDE THE SADDLE CLAMP OVER THEM.
- 5. INSERT THE M4 X 25MM SCREW AS SHOWN IF FIG. 2 THROUGH FIRST FLANGE OF CLAMP.
- 6. HOLD CLAMP SPACER IN PLACE AND SLIDE THE SCREW THROUGH THE SPACER AND THE FLANGE ON OTHER SIDE OF THE SADDLE CLAMP.
- 7. INSERT THE M4 HEX NUT AND TIGHTEN. THE CLAMP SPACER WILL WORK AS A STOP SO THAT THE SADDLE CLAMP CAN NOT BE OVER TIGHTENED.
- 8. APPLY 2 PIECES OF DOUBLE-SIDED TAPE TO TOP OF THE SADDLE CLAMP. (SEE FIG. 2)
- 9. INSERT SPEAKER AND PRESS TIGHT.
- 10. INSTALL THE M4 X 12MM SCREW FROM RIGHT SIDE AND THE M4 HEX NUT FROM THE LEFT SIDE AND TIGHTEN.
- 11. REPEAT THE STEP FOR THE OTHER SADDLE CLAMP AND SPEAKER.
