 - 2 8-32 X 1/4" Slotted Hex Head Cap Screw (HHCS)



- STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.
- Open the fuel door and remove the gas cap. Place a clean dry rag into STEP 2 the filler hole to prevent small parts from falling into the fuel tank.
- Locate the nut on the bottom of the locking mechanism. While STEP 3 supporting the cover, remove the nut with a combination wrench and remove the lock from the fuel door.
- STEP 4 Locate the hinge. Remove the two screws, the fuel door, and the hinge. Make note of the position, and how the hinge is attached, before removing it. Set hardware and hinge aside, they will not be reused.
- STEP 5 Refer to PIC 2. Locate the provided two (2) hinges in the kit. Determine which hinge is specific to the year of your motorcycle by looking at the ends of each hinge.
- STEP 6 Locate provided screws. Reinstall the fuel door and the new hinge in the reverse order that they were removed. Do not over tighten screws.

Note: Refer to you motorcycle's service manual for assistance.

STEP 7 Locate provided Push Button Latch. Install the push button latch into the top of the fuel door then tighten the nut from the bottom. Make sure to support the cover when tightening the nut.

STEP 8

Remove rag from gas cap area and refasten the gas cap. Test the operation of the fuel door latch.

Loosen the nut and readjust the lock if the door does not remain closed when shut.
