FEATURES OF THE TRUNK LID ORGANIZER:

- Trim, functional organizer fits snugly to the inner lid of a classic Harley-Davidson™ Tour Pack.
- Organize your trip packing and maximize your cargo space using the organizer's nine separate storage pockets.
- A variety of elastic bands keep your flashlight, tire gauge and other gear in place, but easily accessible.
- Easily installs to the lid by attaching to the trunk rack hardware or with the included self-adhesive hook and loop fastener tape strips. Installation can be completed in minutes with no modification to your motorcycle.
- Removes in seconds so you can use the convenient carrying handle to take your belongings in the hotel or your home at the ride's end.
- Rugged construction will last a lifetime with its 600D and 150d polyester materials.

WARNING

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLATION!

Because of the variety of motorcycle configurations, other accessories, and the features and intended use of this Saddlemen accessory, there are many different mounting options. You are responsible for the proper installation of this accessory on your motorcycle. Your attention to these installation instructions and recommendations will permit safe and proper use of this accessory. You must mount this accessory properly and securely before riding your motorcycle. If you lack the ability to safely and properly install this accessory, seek out a qualified motorcycle technician for assistance. During installation, support the motorcycle with a suitable stand or lift so it will not tip over and injure you, or damage the vehicle. Using or mounting this accessory improperly could result in a loss of control of the motorcycle which could result in damage to your motorcycle or other personal property, the property of third parties, and/or personal injury to yourself or others, up to and including death.

BE SURE TO THOROUGHLY READ AND CLOSELY FOLLOW THE MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS THAT ARE INCLUDED WITH THIS ACCESSORY:

- Be sure to thoroughly read and closely follow the Mounting Instructions that are included with this accessory.
- The organizer must be installed and securely placed within the trunk of your vehicle.
- For your safety, mount the accessory securely so it will not shift or move while riding. Make sure the accessory will not contact the controls or any other moving parts of your vehicle.
- Thoroughly inspect your organizer before every ride. Do not use your organizer if the mounting system has been modified, or has deteriorated, loosened or is beginning to fail.
- Do not exceed two pounds of total cargo weight, including the weight of the organizer, in the organizer.
- When using this or any accessory, do not exceed your trunk's Maximum Cargo Load Capacity, or your vehicle's Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight as listed on your vehicle or in the manufacturer's owner's manual.
- Carefully secure and protect items placed in, or adjacent to, the organizer (use special care to protect eye wear, shields or helmets).
- Do not transport or store flammable or potentially explosive materials in your organizer.
- Continually check the security of the organizer at each stop as you ride. Mounting hardware or straps on a motor vehicle can loosen during operation, so be sure to check these items frequently.
- If your organizer is ever damaged, do not use it until it has been inspected by a professional motorcycle dealer. Replace the organizer immediately if it has damage that will prevent it from being properly secured to your vehicle or if it is unable to securely hold its contents.
- If you do not understand the Mounting Instructions or this warning label DO NOT mount this organizer and remove any other items you may have installed on your vehicle. Contact your local professional motorcycle dealer for assistance, or call the Saddlemen support line at (310) 638-1222.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO USE THIS ACCESSORY IF:

- You do not understand these installation and use instructions,
- You do not understand any part of the accessory mounting system,
- You have any doubts as to the security of the mounting system.

If you have any concerns or questions, seek help at your qualified motorcycle dealer or call the Saddlemen support line at (310) 638-1222.

Remember: Motorcycling can be a dangerous activity. Installation of any accessory can increase your risk if it is not installed properly. You are responsible to install this accessory so it will not contact any portion of the drive train, suspension or steering, or if it will in any way interfere with the operation of your motorcycle.

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

Socket wrench if removing tour rack mounting hardware to install Mounting Snap Tabs



The images in this instruction set may be different than your accessory or motorcycle.

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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Your Saddlemen Trunk Lid Organizer has been designed to attach easily to the underside of your motorcycle's trunk lid. You (or your professional motorcycle technician) will need to take care when mounting the organizer so it is properly secured to the lid.

The organizer attaches to the inner surface ① of the trunk's lid.

NOTE:

If your trunk is equipped with a Harley-Davidson™ Tour Pack Rack the four included mounting snap tabs can be used to hold the organizer to the trunk lid via the rack mounting hardware ②. These mounting tabs can be used in conjunction with the hook & loop fastener strips that are pre-applied to the organizer. If you do not have the rack on your trunk, attach the organizer with the hook & loop fastener strips only.

Installing the mounting tabs:

To install the mounting tabs ③, use a wrench or a socket ④ to remove two of the acorn nuts securing the rack to the trunk lid. Save the washers and nuts as they will be reused.

NOTE:

Remove only two nuts at a time so the rack will stay attached to the trunk. Do not do any final tightening of the nuts until all the mounting tabs are installed and properly positioned.

Install two of the mounting tabs (preferably the bottom two as the lid is oriented when it is open) to the rack's studs. Put the washer ⑤ on the outside of the tab and then hand-install the nut.

NOTE:

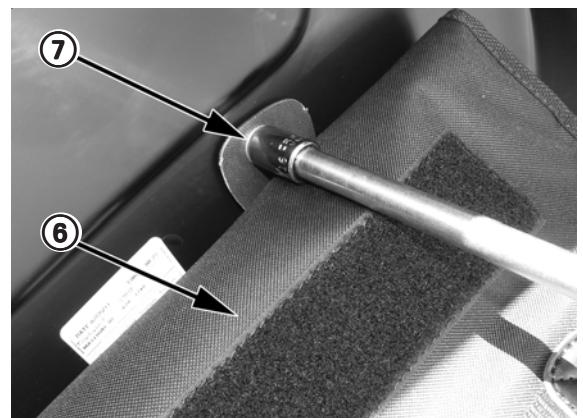
Because of the variance in the construction and the installation of some Tour Pack Racks, you will need to align the female snaps of the mounting tabs with the male snaps on the organizer. Install the nuts back onto the studs, but only hand-tighten them so the mounting tab will still rotate on the stud so you can align it with the corresponding snap on the back of the organizer.

Connect the organizer's two bottom snaps to the mounting tabs snaps. You may need to rotate or adjust the position of the tabs for the snap align with the snaps on the back of the organizer. Once the tabs and the organizer snaps are firmly connected, tighten the rack's nuts to the torque specified by the rack's manufacturer.

Repeat the mounting tab installation and connection to the organizer for the top two rack studs.

NOTE:

You can adjust the tension of the organizer as it is mounted to the trunk lid by rotating or altering the position of the tabs on the rack's mounting studs. After adjustment so the organizer is stretched taut to the lid, make sure all of the rack's mounting hardware is properly connected.



NOTE:

When positioned properly, the flaps ① on the organizer are at the top of each storage pouch. Be sure to orient the organizer in this fashion so items will not fall out when the storage pouch is opened.



Attaching the hook & loop fastener strips:

There are strips of "loop" fastener material across the back of the organizer. Pre-mounted to these strips are corresponding "hook" tape strips with adhesive backs. This hook & loop material is used to secure the organizer to the trunk lid if there is no accessory rack or to add additional mounting security when used with the mounting tabs attached to the rack's mounting hardware.

To install the organizer with the hook & loop material strips, remove the protective tape ② from the back of the "hook" strips.



NOTE:

Make sure the inner surface of the trunk lid is clean and dry before mounting the organizer. Clean the surface with a cleaner that will not leave residue or damage the surface of the inner lid.

Position the organizer ③ to where you desire it to be placed in the lid and press down firmly so the adhesive backing of the strips stick well to the inner trunk lid.

NOTE:

If you are using the hook & loop fastener strips in addition to the mounting tabs, make sure the organizer is snapped in place before pressing down firmly on the adhesive backing.

NOTE:

In about 24-hours, the fastener strip adhesive will be at full strength and you can remove the organizer from the inner lid by separating the hook and loop material.



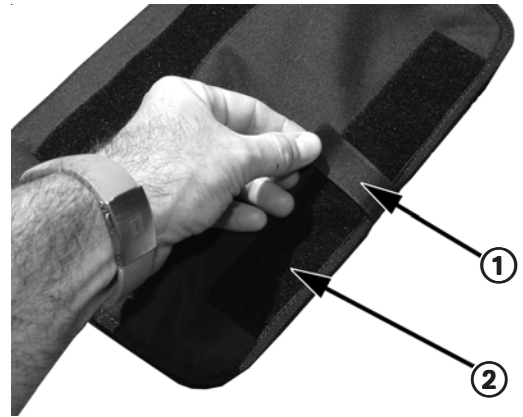
Using the organizer as a briefcase:

To use the organizer as a briefcase, carefully separate it away from the mounting tabs and/or the hook & loop fastener material.

Fold the organizer over at the mid section - the storage pockets will be on the inside of the fold.



Once folded over, the organizer can be secured in this position by attaching the "hook" material tab to the "loop" material strips on the organizer's backside.



Use the carrying handle (3) to tote your organizer and belongings with you.



IMPORTANT:

Failure to install this accessory properly may allow portions of the organizer or its mounting materials to contact the vehicle's control or to interfere with your cargo. It is vital that you verify that the accessory and/or any of its parts will not touch, or interfere with your operation of the motorcycle. It is your responsibility to make sure the installation does not create an unsafe or illegal situation.

After 50 miles (80 kilometers), recheck the mounting of the organizer to make sure it is still securely attached to the trunk lid. Inspect the organizer's mounting before and during each ride. A loose accessory can interfere with the vehicle's operation and cause an unsafe riding condition.



CARE OF YOUR SADDLEMEN ACCESSORY:

Your Saddlemen Organizer requires almost no maintenance, other than periodic cleaning. Use Saddlemen Seat & Saddlebag Ultra Wash (#3101) for the best results while cleaning, or use mild soap and water. Protect the finish and enhance the appearance of your bag with Saddlemen's Seat & Saddlebag Fabric Conditioner (#3103).
